What service CliniCheck and Hillrise Pharmacy are providing?

Clinicheck is a **medical organisation**, managed by GMC-registered physicians. Clinicheck has entered into a partnership with selected pharmacies UK-wide, aiming to offer **quality and effective private healthcare services** to the community. At Clinicheck we are able to address all your **medical testing needs** without the **necessity of a referral** by your GP or a private physician. Our medics provide quick advice on how to address your health concerns, always in strict confidentiality.

The main healthcare service we're offering in partnered pharmacies is **health screening and blood testing combined with medical advice**. This gives you peace of mind that you receive a **complete and responsible medical service**. Taking preventive actions for your health, like annual check up, prevents of being diagnosed with a disease at a non-curable stage. Can GPs offer this? No, unless someone is feeling unwell so blood testing can be justified.

How CliniCheck's blood testing service works?

We offer about **50 profiles** specifically designed to identify any medical condition or to monitor an existing illness. You may call us on **0845 2997031** or email medical-department@clinicheck.com to discuss your concerns and what tests you're thinking to go for. Our physicians will advise which profile can answer best your concerns.

Book the profile selected with your pharmacy and come to have a blood sample taken. **Only 1 blood sample is needed for all your tests. This takes 5 minutes.**

Who takes the blood sample?

Blood samples are taken by Clinicheck's qualified staff (experienced phlebotomist, nurse or a physician).

How and when I get the results?

Most of the **result reports are posted within 24 hours** after the blood sample is taken. Only for specialised profiles, this can take up to 3 days. Your report will include a "diagnostic comment" that "translates" the findings of the analyses into "what now needs to be done". If medics @ CliniCheck see problems with your results, they call you to discuss what steps you need to take to investigate the problem. You may also

call **0845 2997031** or email medical-department@clinicheck.com for advice related to your tests, anytime between 9am-9pm, Mon-Sat. We can **also email your results** to your **personal** email address.

If I have a problem do I have to take it further privately or can also go through the NHS route?

Clinicheck's medics will propose options through the private route and they can secure for you any additional investigation (pathology, imaging, scanning) or referral to see a specialist. Referrals are issued within a day. If your choice is to follow the NHS route Clinicheck can talk or write to your GP (if you instruct us to do so)

Do I need to have a referral to use CliniCheck's blood testing @ Hillrise Pharmacy?

No referral is required for blood testing through CliniCheck.

How I can book my blood tests and what payment options you're offering?

You can pay in cash or cheque. Blood tests and medical services **do not attract VAT**.

Will Clinicheck communicate my result report to my GP?

We **do not contact your GP** unless you've instructed us to do so. Your report is **strictly confidential** and is not disclosed to third parties for any reason.

Can I go to any Pharmacy in my area to get tested?

Clinicheck's medical testing is offered in your area only through **Hillrise Pharmacy**, where you can also get a printed version of this brochure.

Is Clinicheck offering any additional services?

Yes we do: Clinicheck's medics can **issue private prescriptions for medications** required to treat a condition. Talk to your pharmacist or to our medics for more details.

In addition to medical testing, Clinicheck's **nutritional therapists and osteopaths** will also be available on site from **September 2008**. Call your pharmacist or **0845 2997031** for a brochure to see how you can sort out your back pain or movement problems or need to lose weight and manage your body's shape in a long-lasting fashion.

I want to have some medical tests done but cannot see them listed in your profiles.

Is blood testing available to adults and children?

Men and women can use our services in all partnered pharmacies. **Children older than 12** years are also accepted for medical testing provided they are accompanied by their parent (that has been previously in contact with our medics (medical-department@clinicheck.com))

Do I need to starve if I am going to be tested, and if yes, for how long before the test?

We require you **not to have any food** for **three hours** before the test if you are going to be tested for **glucose (blood sugar) or cholesterol**. You can drink as much water as you like but **avoid any other drinks**. If you take tests other than glucose or cholesterol **starvation is not required**.

I suffer from a chronic condition and would like to get myself tested regularly (every week or every month): Do you offer a discount for frequent testing?

Yes, we do offer discounts to those patients that want to monitor a diagnosed health condition. This can be a **profile** or even a **single test**. Please discuss your requirement (condition, test name(s), frequency) with our physician in charge and he will advise on incurring costs (so-

called **Condition Monitoring Cards, CMC**). Call **0845 2997031** or email condition-monitoring@clinicheck.com for advice.

I want to have my urine tested as I suspect I've got a urine infection: What I need to do?

You have to buy a sterile urine container from your Pharmacist the day before urine specimen collection. Wash the genital area with water and soap before producing the urine sample and have an early morning sample collected and delivered to your pharmacist. Do not forget to label the container with your name, surname, Date of Birth and collection date.

I would like to get myself tested for GU infections including a HIV test: How this can be done?

Profiles 14 & 15 are specifically designed to identify any infection related to STDs. HIV testing is also included. You need to talk to our medics on **0845 2997031** or email medical-department@clinicheck.com to get full advice.

I am above 45 years and want to explore if I am at risk to develop a heart disease? Is it possible to identify this through your profiles?

We offer a "cardiovascular Risk profile" (PH8), that measures markers to evaluate cardiovascular risk. We also monitor your **heart function for 24 hrs**. You **do not** need to **stay at bed or take a day off** to do this. You carry on with your regular activities and let us analyze your 24 hr data. We then send you a comprehensive report that can tell if a risk has been identified and what you need to do to investigate or treat an underlying condition. It is good to combine it with the lipid profile (PH 18).

I am thinking of becoming pregnant and want to make sure when this happens I am healthy: Do I have to take any pre-pregnancy-specific tests?

Yes, you need to take the "Antenatal screen" (PH 5) that includes all you need to do to make sure you're not suffering of any infection capable to complicate your pregnancy. If an infection is identified, then we will advise how to cure it and what to do next.

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Is it possible to investigate if myself or my partner have fertility problems that can interfere with family planning?

Profiles PH9 and PH10 are specifically designed to identify factors that may affect fertility in men and women. Call our medical department **0845 2997031** and a specialist will be able to advise in strict confidentiality.

A sperm count is included in the male fertility profile: What I need to do to have this profile done?

We need to advise you how this test is done, so please call our medics on 0845 2997031 to discuss it.

We have had in our family one or more members suffering from a genetic disease. Can myself and family become tested to see if we are carriers or at risk to become ill?
